

Or Kremer, you have been included in *Tatler*'s list of the best UK plastic surgeons for three years running. As a surgeon what made you decide to develop a skincare line?

I used to think that only surgically repositioning facial and orbital fat as well as vertically lifting skin could make us look younger. But this is not so. Skincare is vital to maintaining healthy, plump and fresh-looking skin. I can do the best facelift ever but if a patient's skin is neglected and weathered, the overall outcome will not be as dramatically impressive as it ought to be. If skin is generally well looked after, the treatment will take more easily and last far longer. Skincare is crucial for everyone, regardless of age. It helps skin pre and post treatment. It is one of the first defences against ageing. And so the idea of SkinDoc formula was born.

We meet up with celebrated cosmetic surgeon Dr Kremer ahead of the launch of his brand-spanking new skincare range, SkinDoc formula

My doctoral thesis was written following three years of research in the field of tissue engineering and extensive experience working as a plastic surgeon in a specialist burns intensive care unit. Here, I was responsible for the cultivation and tissue engineering of skin cells for transplantation. This, combined with more than 12 years' cumulative experience as a specialist plastic surgeon enabled me to recognise what human skin needs to maintain or mirror a young metabolism. I began to develop unique, science-based, trademarked formulas. They stimulate and rejuvenate the skin cell's metabolism by mimicking and replacing aged links in a chain reaction. My hydrating serum, eye-contouring cream and collagen serum all form part of my comprehensive skincare range The aim is simple - to keep skin young.

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Is skincare an art?

Most definitely. I want to educate my patients and make them realise that a cream is not just a cream. Creams got smarter. And we have to get smarter about the way we treat our skin. These new-age products all have a very advanced science behind them which is applied to each product to have a specific effect on our skin.
